COVID-19 has both surfaced and exacerbated trends which impact the Canadian economy and the healthcare sector.

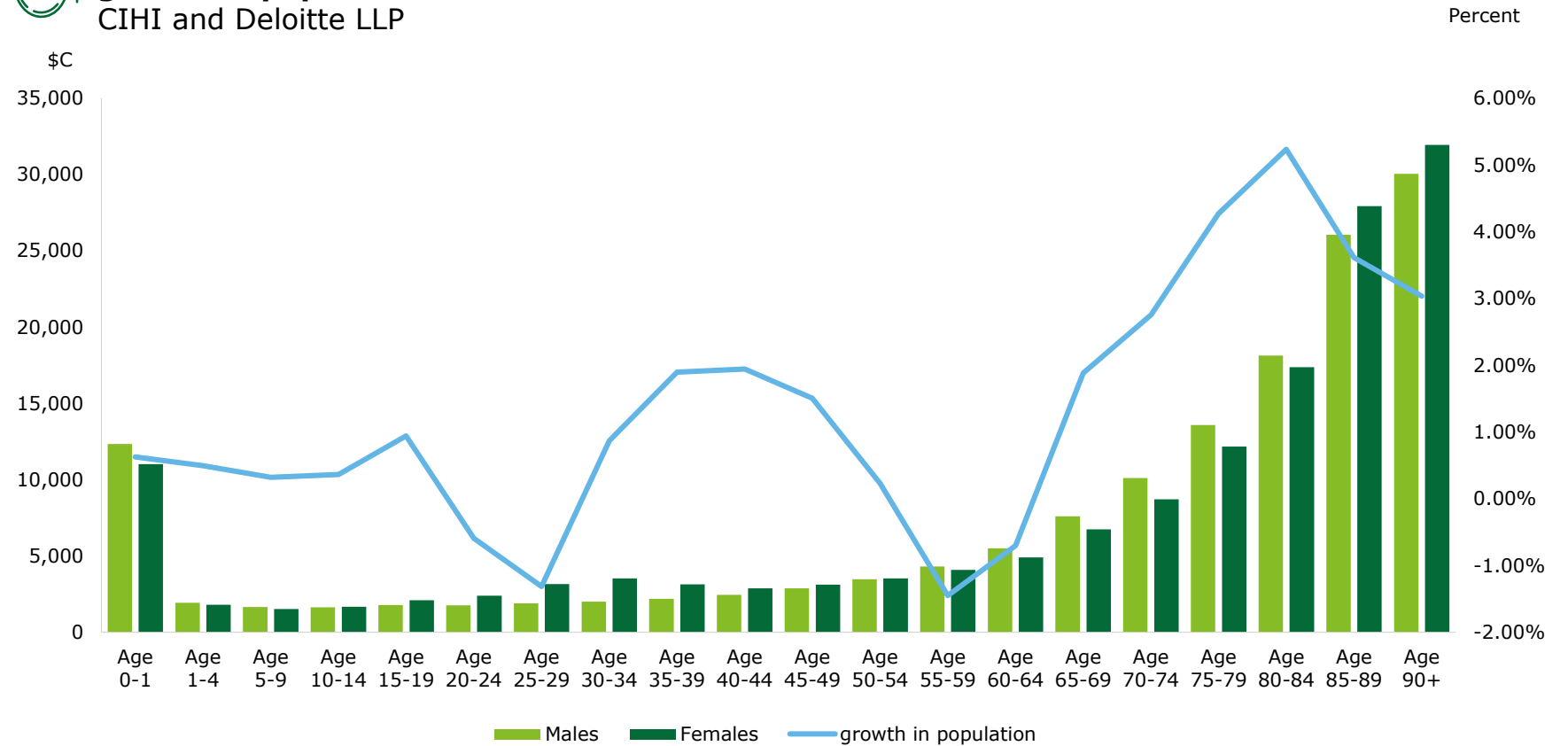

This **project based** funding created by National Research Council Canada provides funding to Canadian SMEs pursuing **technology-driven innovation.**



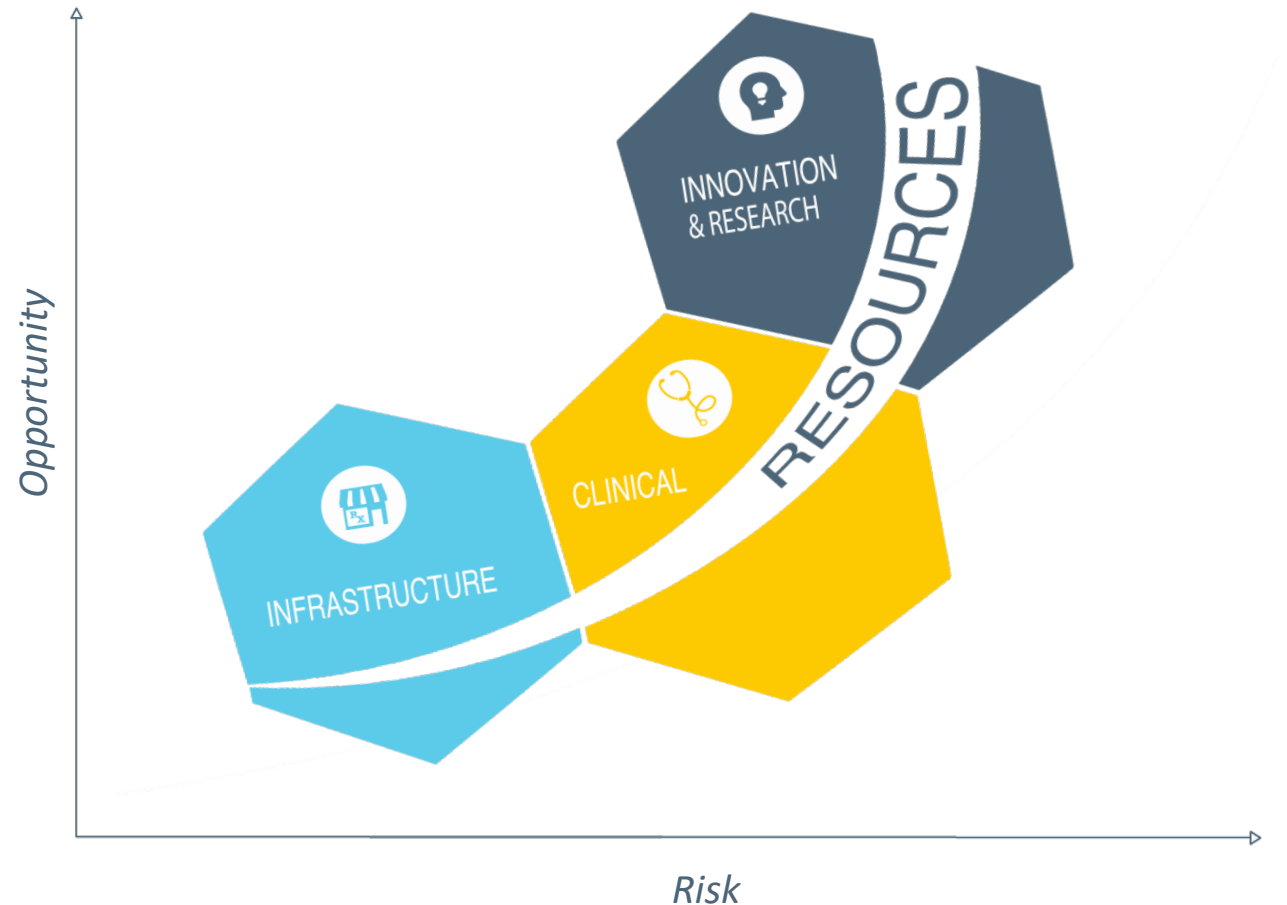

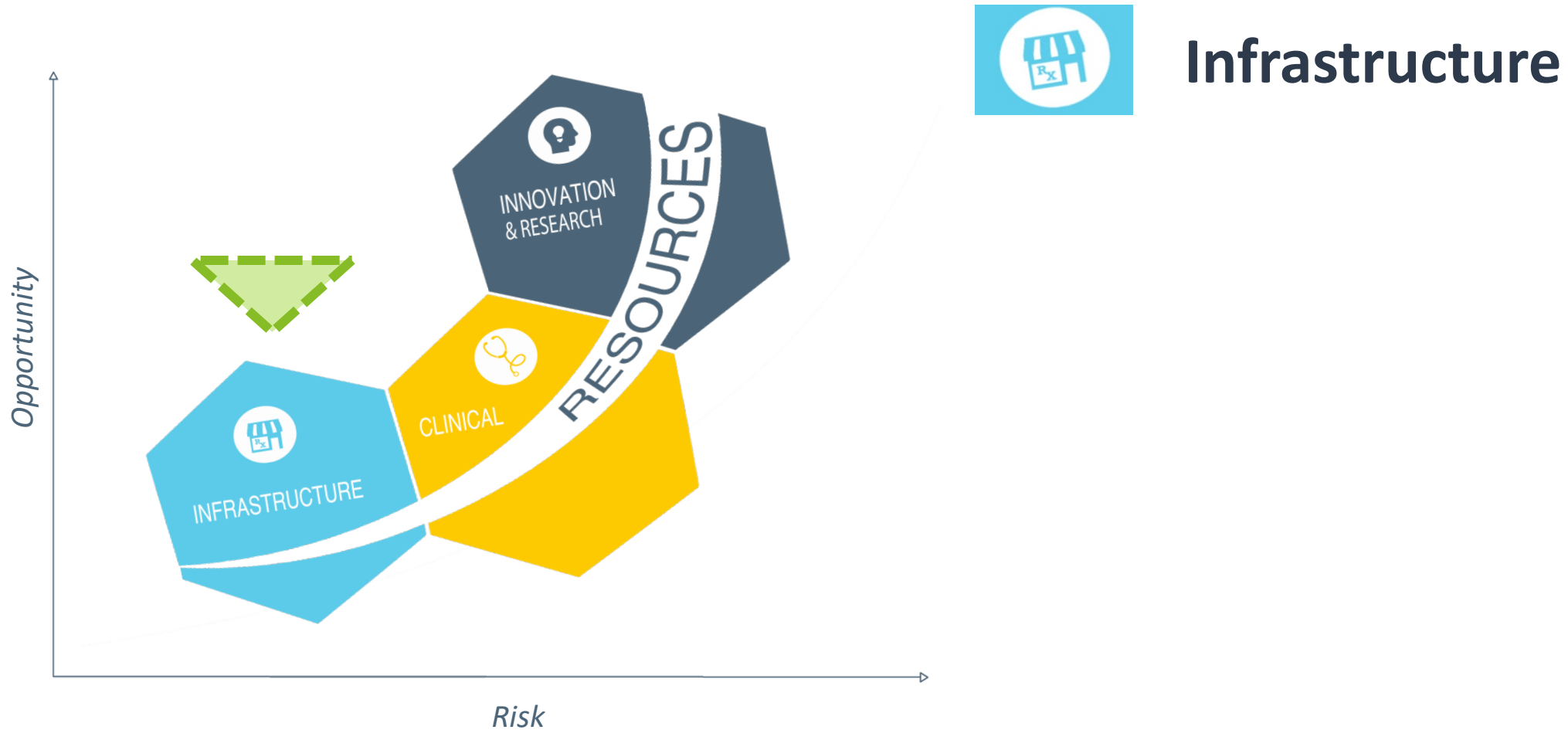
Sinai Health's Strategic Vision
